

## 2018 Annual Report

We provide comprehensive services, including routine medical care, specialized care, and pre and post surgery care to children with complex medical conditions. We believe that every child deserves a fighting chance.



20 % of new arrivals were less than 1 month old. The majority of children (57%) were under 6 months old when we first met them. The youngest child was 1 day old and the oldest child was 13 years old.





- This year, the most common medical condition was Gastrointestinal/ Genitourinary related.
- 17% (22 children) had more than one diagnosis.



71 life-saving surgeries, 41 in-patient treatments & 448 out-patient visits

A total of **59** children transferred out of our care. From those who transferred out, the average length of time receiving care with us was six months (194 days).



17 children adopted (10 month average stay)

15 children transferred to other programs





23 children transferred back to home orphanage

Total expenses for 2018 were 6,024,238.80 RMB (approximately 893,350 USD). This was a 35% increase compared to 2017. In 2018, we also increased the number of children we served by 17% and the number of surgeries we provided by 44%. The total expenses for 2018 don't include volunteer hours, or in-kind donations.


## Family Support Project

17 families (19 children) were supported through our Family Support Project.


Little An is one of the children that benefited
